## **Directions**

**From Charleston: I-77 N**, take exit, **EXIT 77**, bear right, stay in the right lane, you will pass Waffle House and Hobby Stop, bear right at fork. First light, take a right, first building on the left.

**From Charlotte: I-77 S,** to **Exit 77**, turn right at the light, stay in the right lane, you will pass Waffle House and Hobby Stop, bear right at fork. First light, take a right, first building on the left.

**From Asheville: I-85 N** toward **Charlotte**, to **EXIT 102**, toward **Blacksburg/Rock Hill**. Follow **SC-5 S**, you will come to **Main St**, stay straight until you reach **Dave Lyle Blvd**., turn left. You will pass the Civitas Statues, bear to the right at the first ramp, turn right, pass York Technical College and we are located on the left. At the entrance light, the first building on the left.
