(To be successful with electrical diagnostics and repairs to complex electrical systems on cars and trucks the repair technician must have a working knowledge of and understand electrical circuits and how the circuits work, understand repair procedures, and know how to use diagnostic testing meters and equipment properly)

This course is **hands-on** and the exercises and activities explore electrical circuit theory and operation, as well as diagnostic and repair procedures. Topics include: circuit types, electrical circuit troubleshooting, and DMM usage for determining voltage drop, resistance, and amperage. Also included is an overview of connector and terminal repair procedures, and proper use of terminal testing and repair tools.
