### 2012 Annual Meeting Overview



The 20<sup>th</sup> SGFMA Annual Meeting and Equipment Show was held September 23<sup>rd</sup> – September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at the Myrtle Beach Sheraton and Convention Center. By all measures, the meeting was a roaring success. Activities started on Sunday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> with the golf tournament kicking off in the morning and the Chrysler presentation in the afternoon followed by the Vendor Reception. Past SGFMA Presidents were introduced and honored at the reception.

Monday morning began with opening remarks from our President Rick Smith and NAFA's President Daniel Nuck-
